Women of Wisconsin Woodland Owners Association (WOWWOA) Gathering
Saturday, October 21, 2017 from 9:00 am to 3:00 pm at UWSP's Treehaven Field Station**

Enjoy a beautiful morning walk through the northwoods on a mowed road system with WWOA member, WI County Forests Association Executive Director, and forester Jane Severt. She will share her family's woodland ownership history and some of the activities they have done to care for their woodlands. There are several types of forests and ephemeral ponds on the 240 acre property (don't worry we won't walk every acre). We will discuss how different techniques are used to manage different forest types.

After our walk we will enjoy a delicious, warm meal at Treehaven Field Station followed by sharing time. Then Kevin Burns, Vallier Treehaven Forest Ecologist, will demonstrate their new sawmill and discuss wood products. Ryan Clemo, UWSP student, will share his knowledge of edible wild plants.

We will gather at 9:00 am at UW-Stevens Point's Treehaven Field Station's parking lot (near Tomahawk, WI) to carpool to the Severt woodland. We will be able to use the restrooms at Treehaven before carpooling out to the woods. See directions and a map on the next page.

Treehaven is offering rooms for Friday evening. Rooms are \$40/double occupancy and \$80/single occupancy and include washcloth & towel, linens, pillow and blanket. You can also register for the optional Saturday breakfast. Remember to dress for the weather (outdoor and indoor activities) and possibly ticks or other insects. The property we will be walking does not have any buildings or facilities but we will go back to Treehaven for lunch and the afternoon.

Directions:

From North—Take I39/Hwy 51 to Hwy A Exit. Left off Ramp. Continue on Hwy A (east). Hwy A will intersect with Hwy H (Stay on A, left at stop sign). When approaching the Intersection of County Road A and County Road H, stay on County Road A. Do not drive straight onto Drott Road. Go about 2 miles and turn Right on Pickerel Creek Rd. Treehaven is located at the end of the road.

From South: Take I39/Hwy 51 to Hwy A Exit. Right off Ramp. Continue on Hwy A (east). Hwy A will intersect with Hwy H (Stay on A, left at stop sign). When approaching the Intesection of County Road A and County Road H, stay on County Road A. Do not drive straight onto Drott Road. Go about 2 miles and take a Right on Pickerel Creek Rd. Treehaven is located at the end of the road.
