**Aldo Leopold Foundation, E13701 Levee Rd (Rustic Road 49), Baraboo, WI**

*Spend a fall day at the Aldo Leopold Foundation near Baraboo with women woodland owners from across Wisconsin. We'll learn more about Leopold's passions and work. He came to Wisconsin in 1924 and is considered by many to be the father of wildlife ecology and the United States' wilderness system. Leopold was a conservationist, forester, philosopher, educator, writer, and outdoor enthusiast. In 1935, he and his family initiated their own ecological restoration experiment on a worn-out farm along the Wisconsin River outside of Baraboo, WI. During weekends at "the Shack," the family planted thousands of pine trees and restored prairies. Documenting the ensuing changes in the flora and fauna further informed and inspired Leopold. A collection of his essays can be found in "A Sand County Almanac".*

*We will be outside all morning—so dress for the weather—and in the Home Range Hall (with a wood stove) in the afternoon. Join us for coffee and sweets starting at 9:30 am, with the program starting at 10:00 am. Then, we will tour "The Shack" to learn more about Leopold's philosophy and the Leopold Center to see its energy-efficient designs. After lunch, we will share some of Leopold's techniques for documenting changes in his land with ideas on how you can use these to note everyday or special activities/flora/fauna found on your land.*

*The Center is located at E13701 Levee Road is just west of the intersection of Schepp and Levee Roads in the rural township of Fairfield, WI. Note that Levee Road is not always marked as such; look for the brown Rustic Road #49 markers instead. Although signs are posted along certain roads to help you find us, many intersections are not marked. Please call 608-355-0279, if you need directions.
