Directions:

From Shiocton

At WI Hwy 54 and 187, turn north on Hwy 187 for 4.4 miles to Kliner Road. (WWOA Sign at T intersection)
Turn south (right) onto Kliner Road and travel 0.2 miles to Detention Road. (WWOA Sign at T intersection)
Turn east (left) onto Detention Road travel about 0.7 miles to W7004 Detention Road.

From Black Creek

At WI Hwy 47 and 54, go west on Hwy 54 about 1.8 miles to County Rd. P, (WWOA Sign at T intersection)
Turn north (right) on P 2.7 miles until you cross a bridge, turn north (right) onto Thede (WWOA Sign at T intersection) Road and travel 0.7 miles to Detention Road. Turn west (left) onto Detention Road (WWOA Sign at T intersection) Travel about 0.8 miles to W7004 Detention Road.
