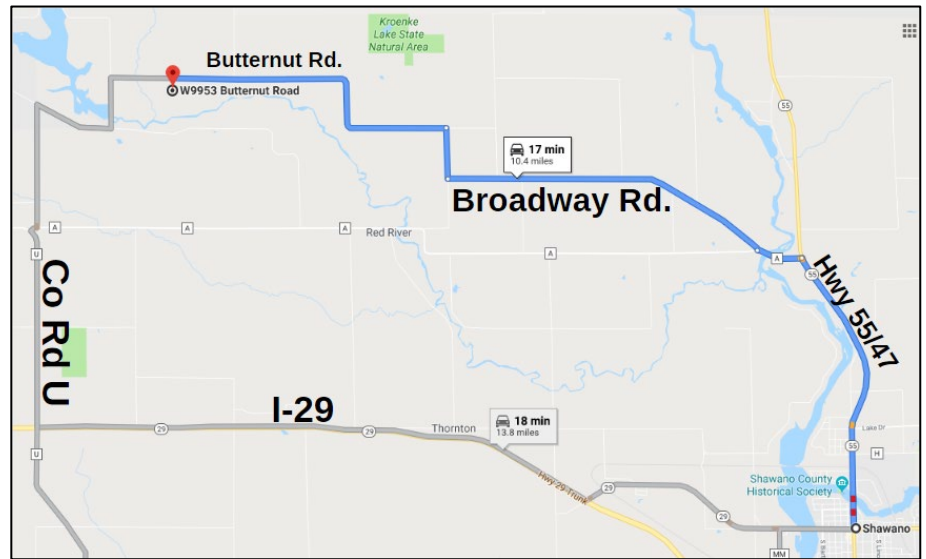

To get to the property from Wittenberg, travel 18 miles on Hwy 29. Turn north on County Rd U, travel 2 miles and take a right (east) onto Co Rd A followed by a quick left (north) onto Highview Rd. Travel 1 mile over a steep hill. Turn right (east) on Cherry Rd, travel 0.7 miles, turn left (north) onto Lower Lake Rd and travel 0.8 miles. Turn right (east) onto Butternut Rd. From Hwy 55/47, turn west onto Co Rd A, follow for 0.5 miles and turn right onto Broadway Rd for 3.3 miles. Turn right at Beech Rd and turn left at the first cross-street, Butternut Rd. Look for the WWOA Open Woods signs to help you find the location

10:00 am – Hit-the-Trail to learn about Tree ID, How Forests Develop, How a Tree Works, Trees as Wildlife Habitat, Deer Exclosures, Old Hemlock Stand, and the Red River
