Spend a wonderful spring day getting to know other women woodland owners, learning more about caring for your land, sharing your thoughts, and having fun in a relaxed camp atmosphere!

Start the day off with casual conversation, warm drinks and sweets at 9:00 am followed by our activities at 9:30 am. After our 'round the table' introductions, we will learn about preventing wildfires, how to make your home or cabin and woodlands safer from wildfires, and when to acquire a burning permit with Amy Luebke, WI DNR. In the afternoon, you will be able to choose between learning about basic pine management or activities for youth and the young at heart. Take a walk with Marcia Frost Vahradian of V's Forestry Consulting LLC to learn how to identify Wisconsin's pines, where they grow, why they are often found in rows, and how to keep these trees healthy. While Mary and Judy Kucksdorf, retired teachers, will share information on forest literature, lead an egg carton scavenger hunt, and help you create twig letter art. We will end the day with Helen Moberg, woodland owner extraordinaire, sharing her spring experiences of turning tree sap into tasty maple syrup from her trees.

We will gather in Sandhill Center at the Mt. Morris Camp on Saturday. You are welcome to spend Friday night in the Center. There are 10 guest rooms and 2 group bathrooms with showers, a kitchen with refrigerator/freezer (please do not use for cooking due to extra fees), great room with fireplace and wall of windows, and basement recreational room. Bring your sleeping bag, pillow, and towels or order the linen package. See registration options below.

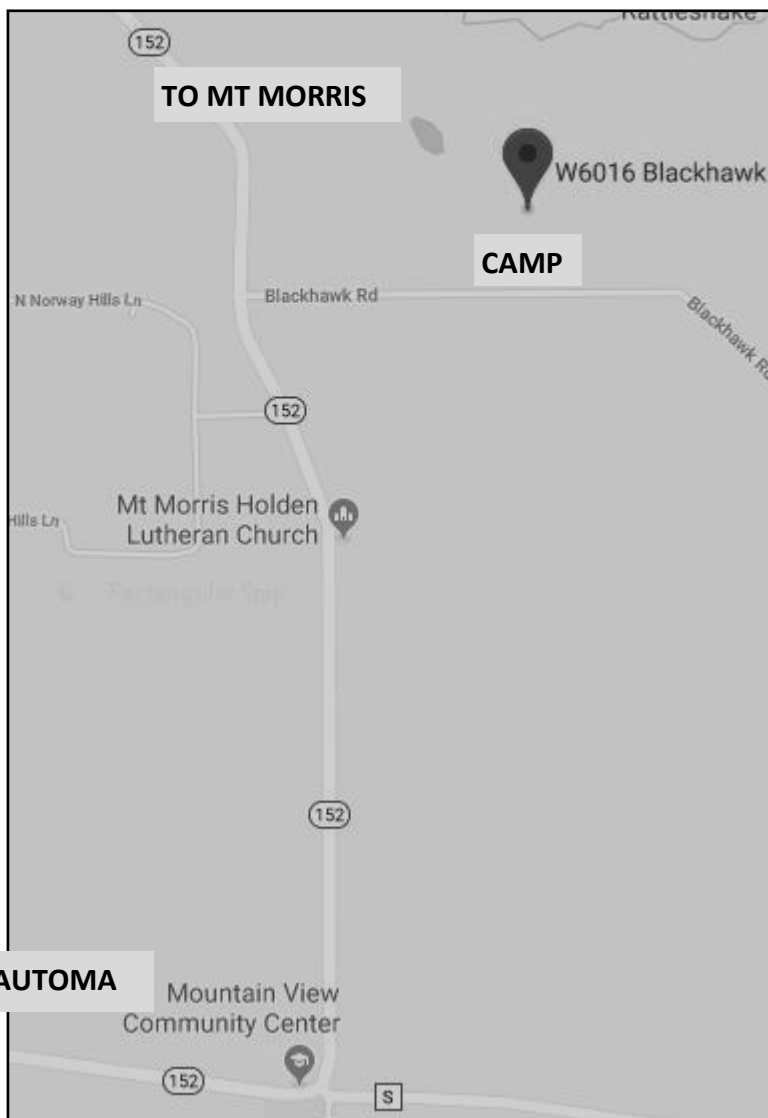
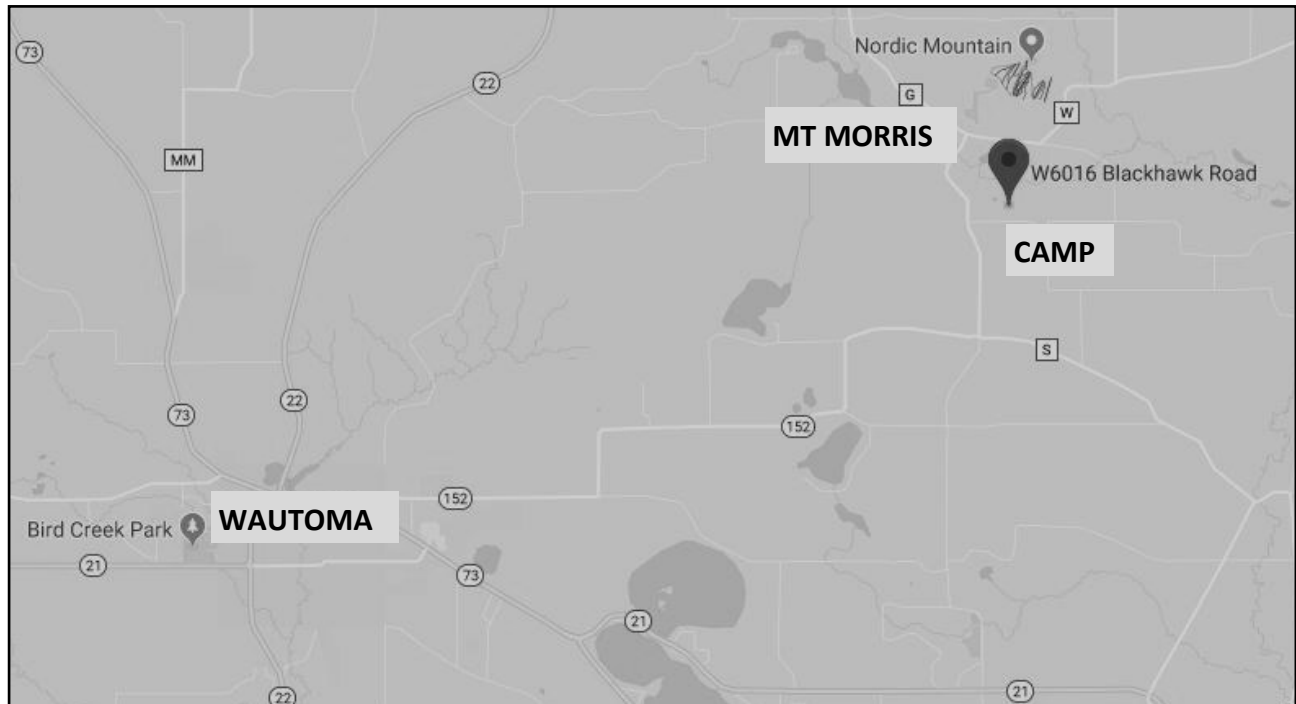

The Mt. Morris Camp and Conference Center is located northeast of Wautoma. Wautoma is located on WI Hwy 21—a major east-west highway.

From the East—take WI Hwy 21 through Red Granite. Just west of Red Granite take Co Hwy S north to WI Hwy 152. Then go north on WI Hwy 152 to Blackhawk Rd.

From the West and South—in Wautoma take WI Hwy 152 east about 7 miles to Blackhawk Road.

From the North—just south of Wild Rose take Co Hwy G south to Mt. Morris. Take WI Hwy 152 south to Blackhawk Road.

The Camp has a sign on Blackhawk Road. As you enter the property follow the road to the left to the Sandhill Center parking.
