To get to the Pogorelnik property from Hwy 34, turn east onto Co Rd E. Turn right onto Peterson Rd. The next intersecting road will be Miller Lane. From I-39, take the Hwy 10W exit 165. Drive west on Hwy 10, then turn north onto Hwy 34 and drive for 2 miles. Turn right onto Co Rd H and drive for 2.25 miles then turn left onto Peterson Rd. Turn left onto Miller Ln. Watch for OPEN WOODS signs.

Tour Chuck Pogorelnik's Eau Pleine Woodlands, the 2018 state Tree Farmer of the Year runner-up and winner of the prestigious Wisconsin Wildlife Federation Forest Conservationist of the Year. Take a walk through the woodland consisting of a mixed hardwood forest, primarily white and red oak, along with hickory, ash, maple, basswood and some aspen inclusions. Get all of your forestry-related questions answered by a WI DNR Forester! See well-managed white pine stands and a previously mowed field-turned 25-year-old forest. It is a perfect example of forest succession and pioneer species! The woodland also includes several wildlife openings and food plots for hunting. Bring a picnic lunch to complement the snacks provided and take in the sights and sounds of nature while you eat.
