We assist in developing a public appreciation for the value of Wisconsin's woodlands and their importance to the economy and overall welfare of the state



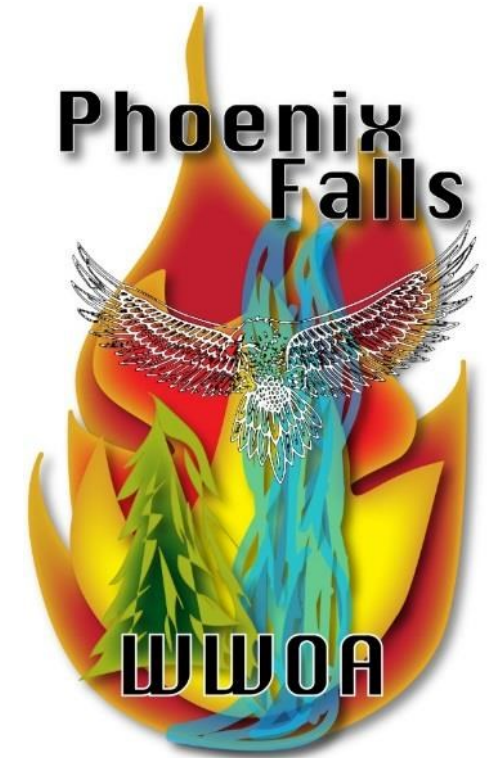
The mission of the Wisconsin Woodland Owners Association is to conserve and enhance the private woodlands of the state through the following actions:
