Join us for a warm summer day where we will get to know other women woodland owners, learn more about our woodlands and invasive plants, and spend the day walking trails in the beautiful Wagner Family Tree Farm's woods.

We will start the morning off with casual conversation, warm and cool drinks, and snacks at 9:00 am. Activities start at 9:30 am. Host, Kathy Wagner will share the history of their woodlands and some of the projects they have completed. Then take a walk with Kathy and Cooperating Forester, Anthony Rynish of Rynish Forestry Inc. We will learn more about how to identify some common invasive plants such as buckthorn, barberry, and garlic mustard and when to look for them. After a picnic lunch, we will learn about various invasive treatment options and the NRCS, EQIP cost sharing program. Then we will take a wagon ride to another part of the property to see areas that have been treated for invasive plants.

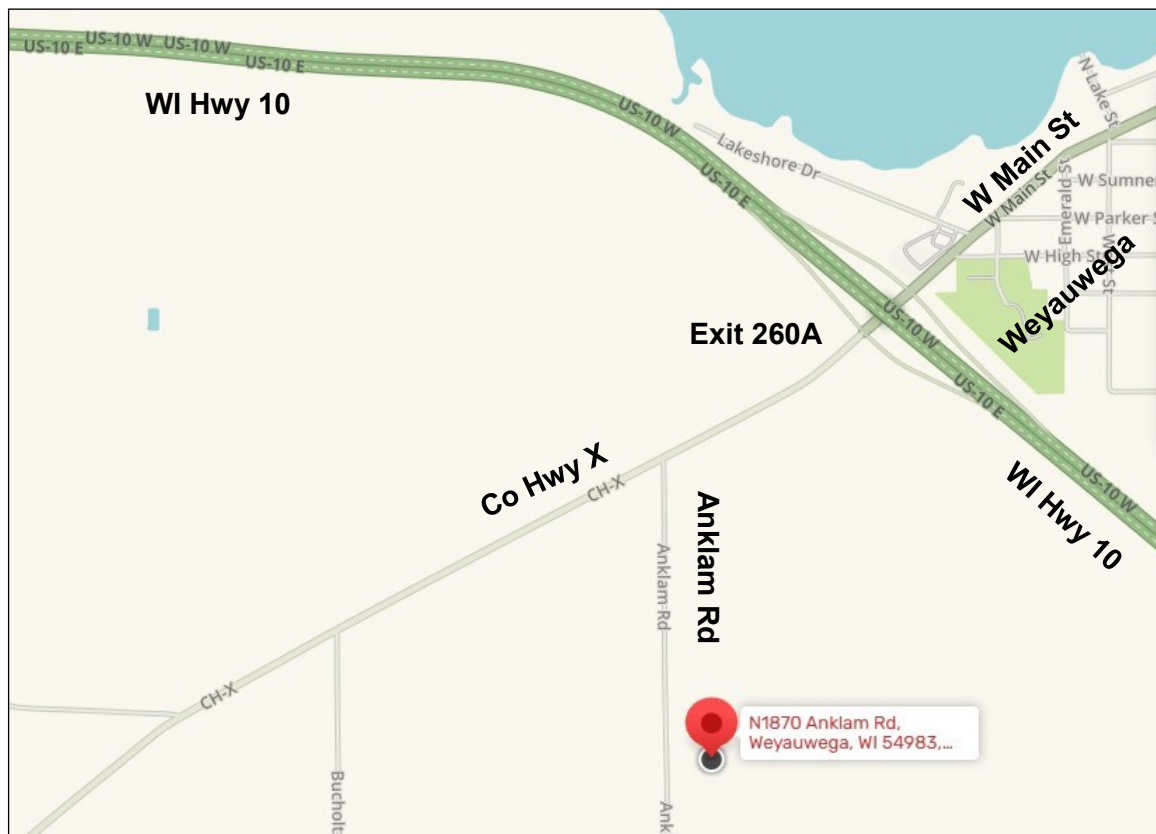

Directions

Coming from the East or West

Take WI Hwy 10 to Exit 260A at Weyauwega. Go south/southwest on County Hwy X to the first road to the south, Anklam Road. Turn left onto Anklam Road and look for WWOA signs.

Coming from the North

Take WI Hwy 110 through Weyauwega to West Main Street. Turn right onto West Main Street and follow it passing under WI Hwy 10. At this point the road becomes County Hwy X. Take County Hwy X to the first road to the south, Anklam Road. Turn left onto Anklam Road and look for WWOA signs.

Coming from the South

Take WI Hwy 49 north to WI Hwy 10. Take WI Hwy 10 west to Exit 260A at Weyauwega. Go south/southwest on County Hwy X to the first road to the south, Anklam Road. Turn left onto Anklam Road and look for WWOA signs.
