BY-LAWS OF THE

WINNEBAGOLAND WOODLAND OWNERS CHAPTER

- 1. WWOC will be consistent with objectives and purposes of the parent Wisconsin Woodland Owners Association (WWOA).
- 2. WWOC will operate under the general guidelines of the Wisconsin Woodland Owners Association (WWOA) and will be a chapter within WWOA.
- 3. Membership and Dues: There will be two categories of membership;
 a) Regular, for owners of Wisconsin Woodlands and must be a member of Wisconsin Woodland Owners Association (WWOA) with voting privileges.
 b) Associate, for any other interested party, non-voting member.
- 4. The annual dues are to be established each year by the Board of Directors. Associate dues are the same as voting members. Membership year is April 1 - March 31.
- 5. WWOC will be governed by a Board of Directors consisting of nine members. The directors terms will be for three years on a staggered basis, therefore there will be an election of three directors each year.
- 6. A director may serve no more than two consecutive terms. Then will be required to take a one year absence before he can be nominated for election to the board again.
- 7. The Board of Directors will meet subsequent to the election and will elect a president, vice-president, secretary and treasurer.
- 8. Five members of the Board of Directors shall constitute a quorum for the transaction of business.
- 9. In the event any director is unable to finish their term in office the Board of Directors shall appoint a new director to fill the vacancy.
- 10. WWOC will hold two program/business meetings and one field day each year.
- 11. The President will appoint two members to audit the treasures financial records within thirty days prior to every annual meeting.
